校長話:「嘉年華」的由來

二月一日下午,本校學生會舉辦了一個「年宵慈善嘉年華」,十一隊主要是來自中三和中四的少年企業家,在校園擺難做生意。當天,生意人別出心裁,顧客排隊掃貨,氣氛熱烈,的確表現出「嘉年華」的特色。這是一次成功的學生活動 — 各攤檔分別錄得微利至厚利,並將利潤兩成捐公益金;同學鍛鍊了組織能力,強化了團隊精神,又做了善事,一舉多得。我在此向各位參加者表示祝賀和欣賞。

順便向同學們介紹「嘉年華」的來歷。

「嘉年華」是英文 carnival 的音譯,原指狂歡的節日,起源於基督教風俗;現在泛指一切狂歡式的慶祝活動或歡樂的集會,不一定跟宗教信仰有關了。

相傳耶穌曾經獨自走到荒野,祈禱沉思,計劃傳道工作,過了四十天流浪生活。 後世的基督徒,為了紀念耶穌的荒野之行,每年守大齋期,又叫四旬齋。

大齋期在復活節前舉行。在這段持續半周至一周的日子,信徒應該禁慾、戒酒, 少娛樂,不吃肉,過著清淡的生活,頗有點苦行的味道。

大齋期的前夕,人們來一番大吃大喝,歌舞狂歡,實行先甜後苦,因為第二天就要守齋過「苦」日子了!

在這狂歡之夜,人們看見桌上的佳餚,不禁感嘆地說:「肉啊,再見了!」在拉丁文,這是 carne (肉), vale (再見), 兩個字合在一起,就是英文 carnival 的來源。把 carnival 譯作「嘉年華」,音義皆妙。

The True Story of a Mainland Boy

I am going to tell you a story about a boy who came to Hong Kong from Mainland China not too many years ago. He had studied in an ordinary school in the Mainland and was the best student in English. However, it was totally changed after he came to Hong Kong. He studied in an ordinary primary school but he only got five marks in his first English exam. He did not understand the paper at all because he did not know most of the words. At last, he got five marks in the multiple-choice part by luck. He felt frustrated but he did not want to give up. He was told to buy a dictionary and a grammar book and it was the turning point of his English.

From then on, he seldom played with his friends or watched TV after school. He always stayed in his bedroom, checking up the words he did not know with his big dictionary. He had to spend at least three hours to finish his English homework because he had to check up at least one hundred words every day. He also copied those words eight times each. Besides, he read a few pages of his grammar book every day. Gradually, he knew more and more words and some basic grammar. Nevertheless, he did not know how to pronounce the words so he was always asking other people. However, he did not want to waste others a lot of time so he tried to learn the phonetic symbols. Gradually, he could know the pronunciations by himself. Do you know what happened next?

As a result, he amazingly got ninety-nine point five one year later. Afterwards, he got ninety something in English every time in primary school.

He was later allocated to a quite famous secondary school. He keeps working very hard and comes first in English every time; he has even become an English tutor.

This is a true story. The boy mentioned above is me.

每星期起碼要做三次帶氧運動。


戒絕酒和煙,包括二手煙在內:吸煙會增加血液中的壞膽固醇。

2006 年,李民標校長的中學母校出版舊生紀念文集,讓校友回憶當年往事。李校長寫了篇「My Secondary School Days」,與當年的同窗真情對話。在這篇二千多字的回憶文字裏,可以讀到李校長中學時代的「瘀事」,也可以清晰看到他的求學經歷,怎樣影響著他今天的治校理念。《清旬》將於本期起分期轉載李校長的「My Secondary School Days」。

To mark the 40th anniversary of the commencement of our secondary schooling, those of us who studied at Queen's College, Hong Kong during the period1964 – 1971 contributed a kind of memoirs essays, to be included in a 600-page volume, and printed in 2006 for private circulation. This article was the "assignment" I handed in, originally only for the eyes of my schoolmates. It is reprinted here for those who may be interested in tracking the roots of my education beliefs.

I was in Form 1A, 2A, 3A, 4W, 5A, 6LA (or was it officially UPJA, for University Preparatory Junior Arts?), and 6UA. But I have yet to leave school, because after 3 years at HKU, I went back to a secondary school and have been working there since, first as a teacher, and for the last ten years, as the principal. Looking back, I am increasingly aware that those seven years at QC has influenced my views on teaching, and so, to a certain extent, has indirectly shaped the minds of thousands of youngsters in my hand.

First week in QC

First week in QC, we were assigned to eight different Houses and were to attend our House AGM. Having become a Crook boy, I rushed, together with another Crook boy from 1A, to reach a place called the Art Room for our first Crook meeting. But we didn't even know how to pronounce the word 'Crook", nor did we know where or what Art Room was. As we were wandering in the corridor, anxiously looking for our place, a teacher happened to pass by. I was too shy to ask him for direction. But my 1A classmate marched boldly up to him and said:" Sin shaang, C-R-O-O-K where...?" I couldn't help laughing at his funny way of saying C-R-O-O-K letter by letter. But well, we all know "he who laughs last laughs best".

Many years later, this 1A chubby boy would rise to be the deputy head of one of the top universities in the world (certainly one of the top two in Hong Kong). His name is Jack Cheng Chun Yiu. From this small episode that took place over 40 years ago, you can see why Jack now heads a university, while I only head a secondary school. Jack may have forgotten this early victory of his, but it has remained in my mind since then. (*Professor Cheng Chun Yiu, is now Pro-Vice-Chancellor of the Chinese University of Hong Kong*)

Chuk Kin says he was punished by Wong Sui Leung, the Head Prefect. Well, I was too. Head Prefect Wong behaved and certainly looked like an imposing figure. On one of his patrol rounds, he caught me scribbling something on the blackboard in our 1A classroom. He signalled me out for a sermon, and then made me write a composition as punishment. I was scared, and wrote a page of something to him. He did a good thing by awarding my d-grade essay a B grade, which lifted me out of my inferiority complex, and has made me remember him ever since. (Mr. Lau Chuk Kin, Chairman of a listed company; Mr. Wong Sui Leung, formerly General Manager Of Photomax, passed away at his prime age)
